

## GUIDELINES FOR ENROLLING IN COURSES FOR GRADUATE CREDIT

A student with senior standing at Georgia Southwestern State University, with an overall academic grade-point-average of 3.0 or better, may register for graduate courses during his/her final two terms of undergraduate work subject to the following regulations:

1. No more than 9 semester hours of graduate credit may be earned.
2. The maximum course load when enrolled in one or more graduate courses is 15 hours per semester.
3. Courses taken for graduate credit cannot be counted toward meeting undergraduate degree requirements.
4. Permission to register for graduate courses must be granted by the Vice President for Academic Affairs prior to registration.
