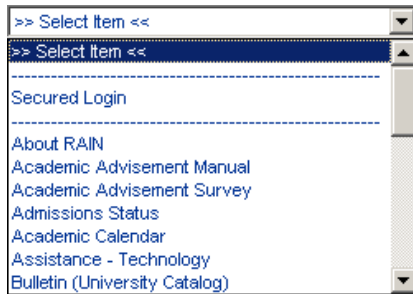


ENTERING SYLLABUS INFORMATION USING RAIN

This does not replace the textbook adoption process.

1. Go to <https://rain.gsw.edu/>
2. Choose secured login from the drop down box.



3. Log in to RAIN with your User ID and PIN.
4. Choose Faculty Services, Syllabus Information, select the Term, and select the CRN.
5. If the course is taught onland (face-to-face) then entering the Required Materials-including ISBN is all that is necessary.
6. If the course is taught online then enter the required information for Georgia ONmyLINE. (Long Section Title, Learning Objectives, Requirement Materials-including ISBN, and Technical Requirements). Do not use any special characters, hyphens, or hard returns in the fields. Click submit and the information is updated in BANNER.
