- Click on the “Appointments” link. Read Information on this page to make an appointment, done through an appointment website.

THE APPOINTMENT WEBSITE

- You will need an account on <https://gsw.mywconline.com/>.
- Once you log on to the website, you will see time slots. White slots are available for consultations. Gray or black slots are not available.
- There is a drop-down menu on top giving options of “in person” and “online” appointments.

GOOD WRITING CENTER PRACTICES

- Make **repeat visits** to the writing center.
- Bring your assignment sheet to the consultation.
- Be on time for an appointment and use the entire appointment time.
- Opt to inform your instructor of your Writing Center visit. They are happy when students visit the Writing Center.

- Making an appointment is easy; each appointment is 30 minutes.
