First aid and safety personnel may be informed, when and to the extent appropriate, if the condition might require emergency treatment, and government officials investigating compliance with the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974, or the Veterans Employment Opportunities Act of 1998 will be informed. 'Disabled Veteran'

A veteran of the U.S. military, ground, naval or air service who is entitled to compensation (or who but for the receipt of military retired pay would be entitled to compensation) under laws administered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, or (ii) a person who was discharged or released from active duty because of a service-connected disability.

'Other Protected Veteran'

A veteran who served on active duty in the U.S. military, ground, naval, or air service during a war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized. For those with Internet access, the information required to make this determination is available at <http://www.opm.gov/veterans/html/vgmedal2.htm>. A replica of that list is enclosed with the annual VETS-100A mailing. 'Armed Forces Service Medal Veteran'

A veteran who, while serving on active duty in the U.S. military, ground, naval or air service, participated in a United States military operation for which an Armed Forces service medal was awarded pursuant to Executive Order 12985 (61 Fed. Reg. 1209) at <http://www.opm.gov/veterans/html/vgmedal2.asp>

'Recently Separated Veteran'

A veteran during the three-year period beginning on the date of such veteran's discharge or release from active duty in the U.S. military, ground, naval or air service.
