- Results of A1 and CT assessment will be available by January 29, 2016
- On the Horizon from the USG General Education Council
 - Overlay requirements are a transfer issue
 - Recognition that overlays are largely redundant
 - Recommendation for removal of overlay requirements
 - Recommendation proceeds to RACAA, and then potentially to the Board of Regents

 - Results significantly below target, especially high percentage of ones.


