<p>Layout: Is it logical? Does it lead the eye around the poster in a reader-friendly manner?</p> <p>Spacing: How effectively are the contents spaced? Is it crowded?</p> <p>Color scheme: Does it facilitate or interfere with poster readability?</p> <p>Font: Style and size; does it facilitate reading?</p> <p>Writing: Is the style and grammar easy to read? Is there too much text?</p>					
POSTER CONTENT:					
Title & Abstract					
<p>Are they both succinct; does every word count?</p> <p>Does the title explain the poster's content adequately?</p> <p>Does the abstract summarize the whole paper, with a focus on the results/ findings and conclusions?</p>					
Introduction					
<p>Is the background sufficiently well-researched?</p> <p>Are the goals, problems or inspiration of this work clearly stated?</p>					
Materials and Methods					
<p>Is all research methodology clear and easy to understand?</p>					
Results & Discussion					
<p>Do the results answer the question being asked in the introduction?</p> <p>Are the interpretations supported by the data or findings?</p> <p>Have all the important results been addressed (supported or defended)?</p> <p>Do they give supporting references for statements made?</p>					
Graphs and Tables and other images:					
<p>Are there useful graphs, tables, or relevant images?</p> <p>Are they technically correct and of the correct style for the type of research?</p> <p>Are they drawn appropriately for reading on a poster?</p>

<p>How well is the poster presented and questions answered?</p>
