<b>Introduction</b>					
Introduction covered the major goals/hypothesis/research question of the talk.

<b>Methods</b>					
All research methods or theoretical approaches – qualitative, quantitative, or both – were explained clearly and logically.

Presentation and interpretation of the Results/ Findings.
