Instructions for Judge 1) Enter your score 5 = excellent, 3 = adequate, 1 = poor in the column below the first Authors name. 2) Add the total poster score					
Design & Aesthetics: Layout: Is it logical? Does it lead the eye around the poster in a reader-friendly manner? Visually Appealing: Are the contents spaced effectively? Is it too crowded/text-heavy? Do the font and color scheme allow the poster to be read easily? Writing: Are the style and grammar easy to read? Is there too much text?					
Poster Content:					
Title & Abstract Does the title explain the poster's content adequately? Does the abstract summarize the whole paper with a focus on the results and conclusions?					
Introduction Is the background sufficiently well researched? Are the goals of this work clearly stated?					
Methods Are all methods appropriate for the study and easy to understand?					
Findings/Results & Discussion Do the results/ findings answer the question being asked in the introduction? Are the interpretations/conclusions supported by the findings or readings? Have all the important findings been addressed (supported or defended)? Do they give supporting evidence for statements made?					
Images, Graphs and/or Tables: Are they all necessary? Are they technically correct and the correct type for the type of data. Are they drawn appropriately for reading on a poster?					
Poster Presentation How well is the poster presented and questions answered?
