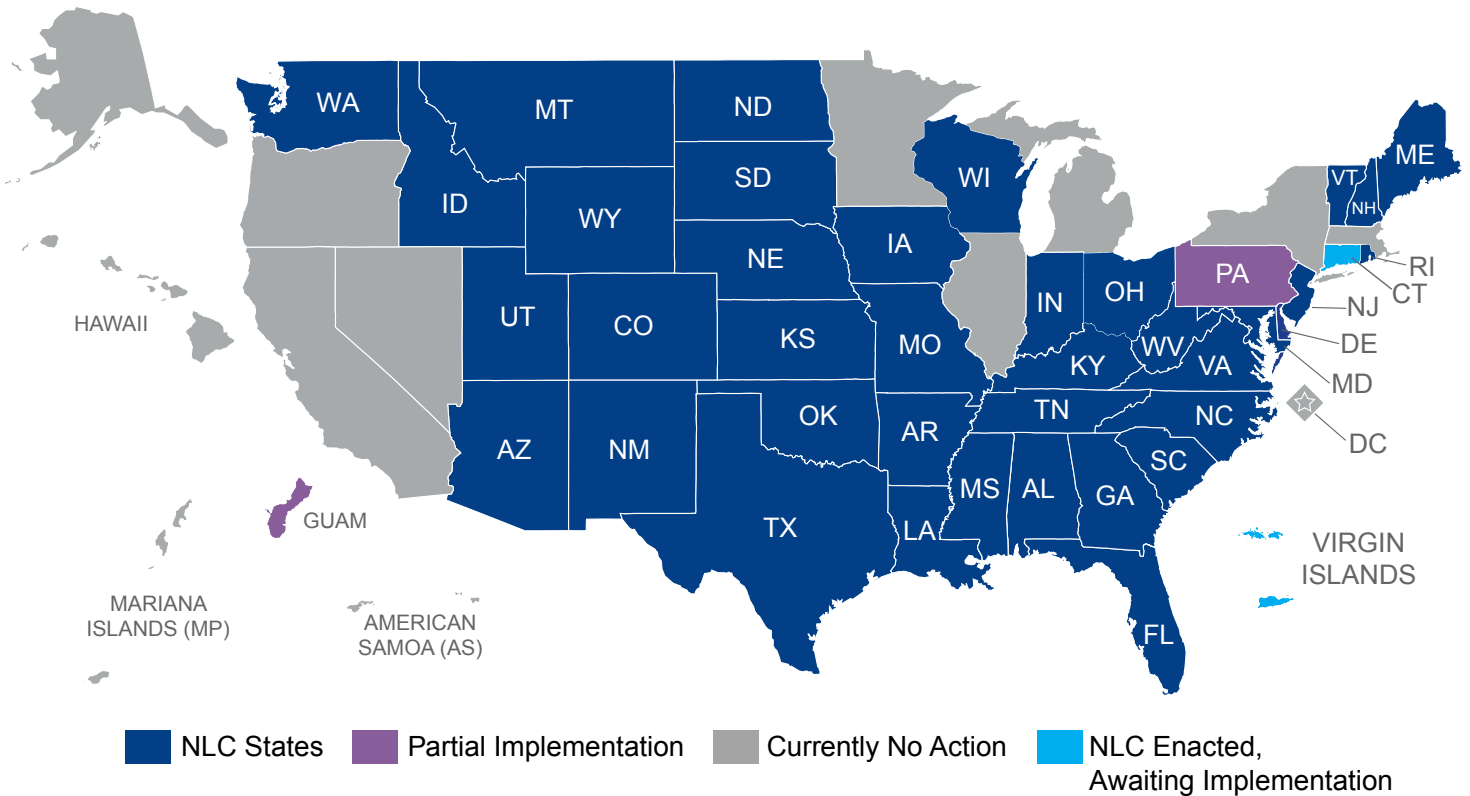



## 42 states have enacted the NLC
