The President Jimmy Carter Leadership Program honors the life and legacy of GSW alumnus and former U.S. President Jimmy Carter who has exemplified a lifetime of leadership in education, politics, community service, eradication of diseases, and world peace.

About the Program

The program consists of two pathways: an undergraduate research track and a service track.

Year 1: students focus on individual growth & development
Year 2: students work collaboratively in a group setting
Year 3: students choose between research or service track
Year 4: students develop senior research or service project

Minimum Requirements to Apply

- Score a minimum 1100/SAT or 22/ACT
- Hold 3.0 GPA or higher
- Possess strong leadership skills
- Held a leadership role in high school

Scholarship

 Scholarships range from \$1,500 - \$3,500: a guaranteed \$1,500, plus either \$1,000 or \$2,000 from the Southwestern Promise scholarship

Program Requirements

- Live on campus the first two years of the program
- Maintain a college 3.0 GPA or higher
