WHAT CAN BOOSTERS DO THAT IS PERMITTED?

Boosters can let coaches know of outstanding prospects in their area, and can observe a prospect's contest as long as they booster does not have any contact with the prospect or his/her parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s). If the prospect is a neighbor, relative, or family friend, you may have a relationship with him/her, but cannot be involved in the recruitment process of that particular prospect.

If a prospect knows you are a GSW booster, he/she can phone you as long as the prospect initiates the call. Please direct any questions from the prospect about GSW Athletics to the athletics staff.

In addition to recruiting help, boosters can also provide an occasional meal to current student-athletes as long as the meal is at the booster's home. Boosters may provide tickets to a movie or other reasonable entertainment for current student-athletes when the team is at away games.

WHAT IS NOT PERMITTED FOR BOOSTERS?

Boosters cannot:

- ⦿ Write, call, make in-person recruiting contacts with a prospect or his/her parent(s) and/or legal guardian(s);
- ⦿ Make a recruiting presentation to prospects;
- ⦿ Contact a prospect's high school coach, principal or counselor to evaluate the prospect;
- ⦿ Visit a prospect's high school to obtain a transcript, or make a video in order to evaluate the prospect's academic or athletic ability nor can a booster provide this information to an athletics staff member;
- ⦿ Provide extra benefits to a prospect, current student-athlete, or their friends and relatives;
- ⦿ Make use of a student-athlete's name, picture or appearance to promote sales, or to advertise a particular product or service.

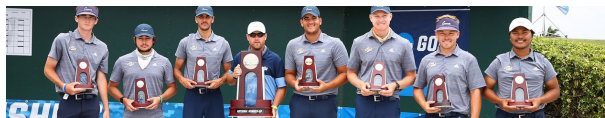


CANES 360 is a group of people dedicated to the rapid turnaround of resources available to the Georgia Southwestern Hurricane Athletics program. We have a devoted coaching staff and enthusiastic student athletes. A look at the highlights of the past year in the following column indicates some of the outstanding achievements of our players and teams.

2020-21 INDIVIDUAL & TEAM HIGHLIGHTS



The men's golf team brought home the 2021 **NCAA Division II National Runner-Up** trophy after advancing to the championship match. Junior Chase McLain finished the year **No. 19 in the country** and junior Saksit Jairak was **24th** in the final Golfstat computer rankings.



The men's basketball team earned an invite to the **NCAA Division II Basketball Tournament** for the third time in program history. Junior Donte Tatum was named to the **National Association of Basketball Coaches 2020 All-South District Team**.



Baseball senior Tucker Smith was named the **Peach Belt Conference Pitcher of the Year** for the second consecutive season. He's the third pitcher in PBC history to repeat as Pitcher of the Year. Tucker was also named the 2020-21 **PBC Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year**.



The Hurricanes finished **fourth in the country** in the 2020-21 Team Works/Community Service NCAA DII Competition to be inside the Top 5 for the third consecutive year. Every GSW team completed more than 160 volunteer hours with a 92 percent participation rate across the department. In all, **6,273 hours** were served by Hurricane athletes.



11 student-athletes earned the **Peach Belt Conference Presidential Honor Roll's** top status of "Gold Scholar" in 2020-21. A total of 92 Hurricanes posted a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
